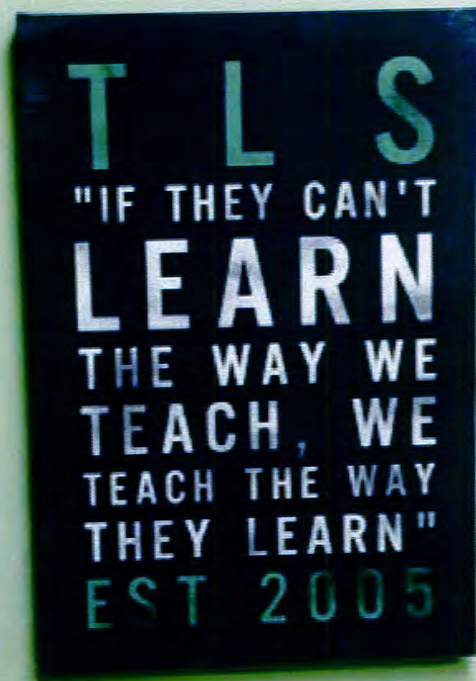

Why Choose The Learning Spectrum Inclusion Services?

The Learning Spectrum provides naturalistic programming for children with ASD and other disabilities based on the premise that behavioral intervention and immersion in the natural environment are the keys to establishing learning behaviors in students. The most current research reports that naturalistic intervention is the most beneficial approach when facilitating the development of social skills in children with ASD.

Naturalistic programming also utilizes a variety of techniques to teach the child to monitor his/her own behavior. These may include removal from an activity until more appropriate behavior occurs, or targeting specific activities or objects that are reinforcing to the child and using them to help shape more appropriate behavior. The Learning Spectrum utilizes ABA techniques combined with strategies that promote engagement with the natural environment, generalization, and mastery of skills. TLS bases programs on each child's unique needs. The goal of The Learning Spectrum is to help all children reach their full potential through a personal program designed to meet their own needs

The Learning Spectrum works currently with several schools, daycare centers, school districts, and other educational settings that are serving children with Autism Spectrum Disorder and other disabilities.
