Purpose:

Assure all individuals who utilize Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) services meet the eligibility requirements outlined in Ohio Administrative Rule 5123:2-1-02, County Board Administration.

All individuals requesting an eligibility assessment must verify the presence of a qualifying diagnosis, and must participate in the assessment process.

DCBDD will complete reassessments minimally as required, but may reassess program eligibility at any time.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible to receive services and supports from the Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities an individual must meet the following:

- 1. Be a resident of Delaware County. The county residence of an individual shall be determined in accordance with ORC 3313.64. In the case of a child placed out of the parent's home, the county responsible for developmental disability services shall be the same as ORC 2151.362.
- Meet the Eligibility criteria of "Developmental Disability" as defined in OAC 5123:2-1-02.
- 3. For children under age three, developmental delay shall be established in accordance with Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. 1431 through 1445, and defined in C.F.R. 303.10 as well as OAC 5123:2-1-02.
- 4. For children age three through age five, developmental delay shall be established in accordance with the Ohio Department of Education as defined in OAC3301-51-11 and OAC 5123:2-1-02.

Eligibility will be determined within 45 calendar days after necessary information has been received.
