Please express our thanks to all of the Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) staff that volunteered their time and energy to the PIN Food Drive. Because of your hard work, 271 pounds of food was collected and delivered to PIN. This translates into an additional 225 meals that we will be able to provide. The collection also provided 81 pounds of personal hygiene items that will be available for our clients to select as well as \$60 in cash that we will be able to direct to pantry needs as they arise. All of this is on top of you and your group of volunteers working in the food pantry on July 20<sup>th</sup> to glue our food boxes in preparation for upcoming collections!

The "icing on the cake" for us was the TV news segment that you arranged to have shot at the PIN Food Pantry. That kind of exposure is invaluable to an organization like PIN.

Delaware County is one of the fastest growing counties in Ohio. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the 2007 population of Delaware County was 160,698. Today it has increased to more than 193,000 residents. At the same time, we have seen an increase in the need for basic human services. In 2007, PIN provided emergency assistance to 9,081 residents. During fiscal year 2017, we served more than 21,400 and the need continues to rise. Your support, and the support of those like you, is essential for PIN to be able to implement its mission.

Regulated by the Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA), MidOhio Food Bank and the Delaware County Health Department, we are subject to annual inspections and must abide by the rules and regulations set forth by these agencies.	
Since 1981, PIN has been providing food and emergency services to residents of Delaware County. We currently provide a four-day supply of food for each member of the household; twelve meals per individual. Clients are able to access our food pantry once a month and are also able to obtain fresh produce and bakery items three additional times.	
As the population of Delaware County has grown, so has the need for our services. Your monetary gifts, donations of baked items, non-perishable food, produce, school supplies and taxable items are vital to sustaining this program.
