RE: Early Intervention and the Core Team Primary Service Provider Approach

Dear Early Intervention Providers:

The Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) is now accepting informal Requests of Interest (ROI) for our Early Intervention Core Team Primary Service Providers.

DCBDD is currently seeking speech therapists, occupational therapists, and physical therapists to join our Core Teams. As part of Core Teams, therapists will work with Service Coordinators and Developmental Specialists from DCBDD to provide early intervention services to children (ages birth through two years old) with developmental disabilities in Delaware County.

Therapists will be contracted for up to 40 hours per week and will be compensated at \$65.00 per hour. Periodic training will be required to meet minimum program standards. Such training will be paid at the regular contracted rate of \$65.00 per hour for each therapist.

To be considered for the Core Team, therapists must:

- Maintain a flexible schedule to accommodate children served and team needs;
- Be willing to work in a designated area of Delaware County;
- Participate in mandatory trainings and meetings including, but not limited to, weekly Core Team meetings, Individualized Family Service Plan meetings, and contract management meetings, as scheduled;
- Be willing and able to implement program requirements in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract, Individualized Family Service Plan, applicable policy, and applicable law;
- Comply with certain invoicing and service documentation requirements and accept the contracted compensation rate of \$65.00 per hour;
- Carry insurance limits, as applicable, in accordance with the contract requirements for general liability, professional liability, employer liability, automobile, and worker's compensation coverage;
- Provide documentation of LLC, Agency with Choice, or Agency status (pending DCBDD Board approval).
